RightShift® 2 Overview



- 1 Mini-USB port
- 2 Power Switch
- 3 Bluetooth link button
- 4 Caps lock indicator
- 5 Bluetooth connection indicator - The blue LED light stays on if not paired with your iPad.
- 6 Charge indicator – A red LED light will flash when it's time to charge your keyboard. It will stay on while it's charging and turn off when the keyboard is fully charged.
- 7 Power indicator
- 8 Home button – Pressing this button will take you back to your iPad's home screen.

Getting Started

Your RightShift keyboard's built-in Lithium ion battery is shipped with a limited charge. We recommend charging it for a full 4 to 4.5 hours before attempting to connect it to your iPad 2.

To charge the battery:

1. Replace the USB cable on your iPad's AC adapter with the USB to micro-USB cable that came with your RightShift keyboard.
2. Connect the micro-USB end to the RightShift's micro-USB connector. The red indicator light will remain ON while charging and turn OFF when fully charged. You'll know it's time to recharge the keyboard when the red light starts blinking.

Charging Tips

While it's possible to charge the RightShift by attaching it to a high-power USB port, be aware that it will do so much more slowly. Further, if you're going to connect the RightShift to a USB port on a PC or older Mac, you'll need to make sure that the computer is ON and that it doesn't go into sleep mode while charging.

Installing the iPad into the Case

1. Position the iPad so that the controls align with the cut-outs on the case.
2. Holding the iPad at an angle, slide it into the case.
3. Gently press down until the iPad snaps into place.

Pairing the RightShift™ Bluetooth® Keyboard with Your iPad

1. Select Settings on the iPad screen.
2. Select General to bring up the Bluetooth option.
3. Turn ON Bluetooth.
4. Slide the power switch on the RightShift keyboard to the ON position.
5. Press the Bluetooth pairing button on the keyboard.
6. Select the Bluetooth Wireless Keyboard on your iPad. This will generate a pop-up screen that will display a numeric passkey.
7. Type the passkey using the keyboard, followed by the Enter key. (The passkey is not displayed as you're typing it. If a connection is not made, it's possible that you might have typed it incorrectly. Repeat the process if the unit fails to connect.)

Your RightShift keyboard is now ready for use.

IMPORTANT: Once your keyboard is paired with the iPad, you do not need to press the Bluetooth pairing button again. Doing so will disconnect your keyboard from your iPad, and you'll need to repeat the connection process outlined above.

Troubleshooting Tips

If your keyboard isn't working, make sure that...

- ...the keyboard has enough charge.
- ...the keyboard's power is in the ON position.
- ...Bluetooth is enabled on your iPad.
- ...make sure your keyboard is paired with your iPad.

If none of the above is the problem, then try rebooting your iPad. To do this, hold the LEEP button for five (5) seconds until the "Slide to Power Off" message appears.
