
Functions & Controls


Power and Charging the Internal Battery

DC Power input: requires an AC/DC adapter, or 12V DC car adapter (included).

TO POWER THE UNIT, plug the included AC/DC adapter into the unit and a standard wall outlet. For use in a car, plug the 12V DC car adapter into the unit and a standard 12V Power outlet in the car.

The Power Indicator will turn green whenever the portable DVD player is Powered ON. The Charge Indicator will turn red whenever the battery is charging.







Menu

Press to access the DVD menu.

Arrows

Press to navigate menus.

Skip Back/Fwd/F. Fwd/Rev

Press to skip between chapters or tracks. Press to fast forward or reverse.

Play/Pause

Press to play or pause the loaded disc.

Press to stop play of the loaded disc.

Setup

Press to access the setup menu.

Source

Press to select DVD/AV In/MCR/USB.

Volume/OK/Arrows

Press to select and navigate on-screen menus. Press and hold to adjust the volume.

Charge Indicator ...

Turns red when the portable DVD player is charging and off once the unit is fully charged.


IR Remote Receiver Power Indicator

Turns green when the portable DVD player is powered ON.

Remote Battery

Requires two AAA batteries (included).



Display ON/OFF

Press to turn the screen ON or OFF.

Title

Press to access title menu for DVD.

Menu

Press to access a DVD's main menu.

Skip Back/Fwd

Press to skip between chapters or tracks.

Arrows/Enter

Press to make selections in the on screen or disc menus.

Setup

Press to access the setup menu.

Number Keypad

Enter chapter/title to play.

Press to create a repeating loop on a loaded DVD.



Press to program a loaded disc to play chapters or tracks in a specified order.

Zoon

Press to zoom in or out on a playing DVD.



Source

Press to select DVD/AV In/MCR/USB.

Subtitle

Toggle subtitles ON or OFF.

Go To

Press and enter a track, chapter, title or time to skip directly to a point on the disc.

Rewind/F. Fwd

Press to search through an individual chapter or track.

Volume +/-

Play/Pause

Audio

Press to adjust the current audio settings for the loaded DVD.

Mute

Press to mute the volume.

Display

Displays current title and menu information.

Repeat

Press to repeat the current track or selection.

Angle

On supported DVDs, press and hold to view alternate angles.

Connecting & Playing Media

Accessing the Setup Menu

To access the Setup Menu, press the **Setup** button on the player or the remote.

Loading and Playing a Disc

- 1. Slide the **Open** latch to open the **Disc Door**.
- Load a disc into the **DVD player**, label side facing up. Close the **Disc Door**. After a disc is loaded, it will begin playing automatically.
- If the disc does not begin playing automatically, press the Play/Pause button.

Programming a Loaded Disc

- 1. While the loaded disc is playing, press the **Program** button on the remote.
- 2. Use the **Arrow** buttons to select a program
- 3. Use the **Number Keypad** to enter in the chapter and title, or track.
- 4. Titles and chapters, or tracks will play in the order they are listed.
- 5. Repeat step 3 until the desired titles and chapters, or tracks are programmed.
- 6. Use the **Arrow** buttons to highlight the onscreen START button. Press the **OK** button to begin playing the programmed disc.

Connecting a Memory Card

AVI, VOB, MPEG 1, MPEG 2 and MPEG 4 video formats are supported. *Note: Formats are not universally compatible. Playback may be dependent on recording conditions.*

- Connect a SD or MMC memory card to the Memory Card Slot.
- Press the Source button to enter the DVD/AV In/MCR/USB menu.
- Use the Up/Down Arrow and Enter buttons to select MCR mode and play content from the connected memory card.

Connecting a USB Thumb Drive

AVI, VOB, MPEG 1, MPEG 2 and MPEG 4 video formats are supported.

- 1. Connect a **USB thumb drive** to the **USB Port.**
- Press the Source button to enter the DVD/AV In/MCR/USB menu.
- Use the Up/Down Arrow and Enter buttons to select USB mode and play content from the connected USB thumb drive.

Using the 3.5mm AV Input

Requires a 3.5mm to 3 x RCA audio/video cable (included).

- Connect the 3.5mm to 3 x RCA audio/video cable to the AV Input on the unit and the composite video outputs on an audio/video source, such as a TV.
- Press the Source button to enter the DVD/AV In/MCR/USB menu.
- Use the Up/Down Arrow and Enter buttons to select AV In mode. Audio/video played on the connected source will now be output to the portable DVD player.

Using the 3.5mm AV Output

Requires a 3.5mm to 3x RCA audio/video cable (included).

- Connect the 3.5mm to 3x RCA audio/video cable to the AV Output on the unit and the RCA stereo audio inputs and composite video input on a television.
- Audio and video played on the portable DVD player will now be output to the connected television.
