



Product Diagram (DK30CHPH)

Installation

Notes: Installation is automatic for all modern Operating Systems.

Shutting down the **iPad Pro**® (not sleep mode or restart) and leaving it connected to the **Docking Station** before powering it back on, may result in no HDMI video output, If this happens, disconnect and reconnect the 1M **USB-C Cable** (included) from the **USB-C Host Port** on the front of the **Docking** Station.

Windows 7 (and earlier) Driver Installation

1. If the **Found New Hardware** dialog box appears on the screen, close the dialog box or click **Cancel**.

Note: Once the **Docking Station** is connected to the **Host Device**, and if no existing **Drivers** are found, the **Docking Station** will load a **CD-ROM Device** that contains an executable file that can be used to install the **Driver**.

- 2. After the **CD-ROM Device** finishes loading, run the **Installation File**.
- 3. Complete the on-screen instructions to finish the installation.

Connect a Host Device

 Connect the 1M USB-C Cable (included) to the USB-C Host Port on the front of the **Docking Station** and to the **USB-C Port** on a **Laptop**, **Computer**, **Phone**, or a **Tablet**.

Connect USB Peripherals

• Connect up to two USB 2.0 Peripherals to the USB 2.0 Ports on the rear of the **Docking Station.**
