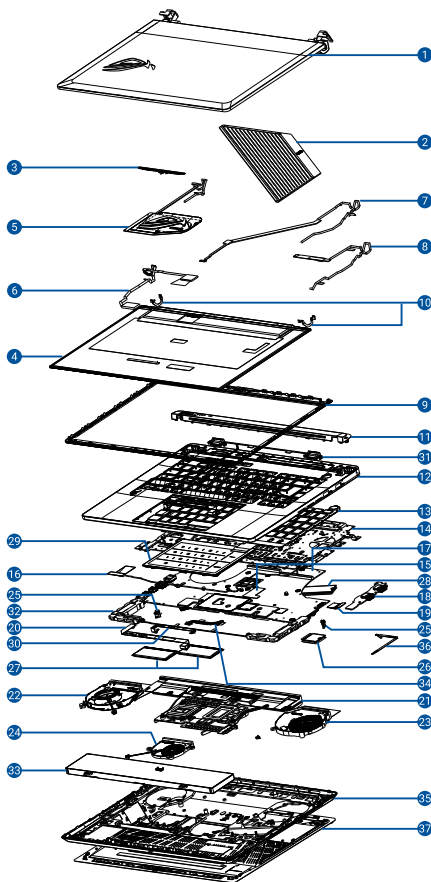

Bottom cover



Before you begin

Read the **Safety Precautions** and complete the **Pre-repair Checklist**.

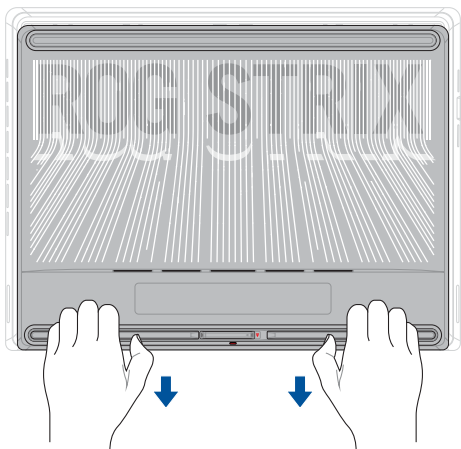
Removal

IMPORTANT! System power will be cut off automatically upon removal of the bottom cover. To restore power, reattach the bottom cover securely and connect the AC power adapter to your Notebook PC after the servicing is complete.

1. Push the slide lock to the left to release the bottom cover.



2. Ensure the bottom cover is unlocked, then use both hands to slide out the bottom cover until you hear a click.
3. Lift and remove the bottom cover.



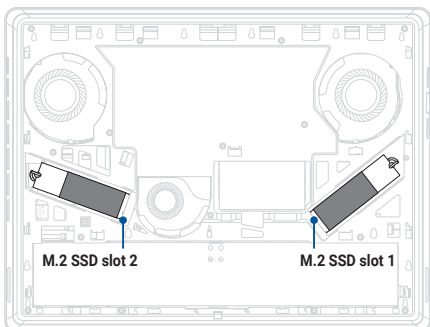
Installation

IMPORTANT! System power will be cut off automatically upon removal of the bottom cover. To restore power, reattach the bottom cover securely and connect the AC power adapter to your Notebook PC after the servicing is complete.

Align and slide the bottom cover back in place until you hear a click.



M.2 SSD module

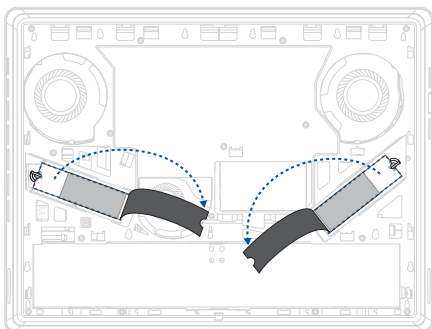

NOTE: (For models G615JHR, G615JH, G615JMR, G615JM and G615JPR) The M.2 SSD slot 1 supports PCIe 5.0. Ensure your PCIe 5.0 M.2 SSD is installed in M.2 SSD slot 1 for optimal performance.

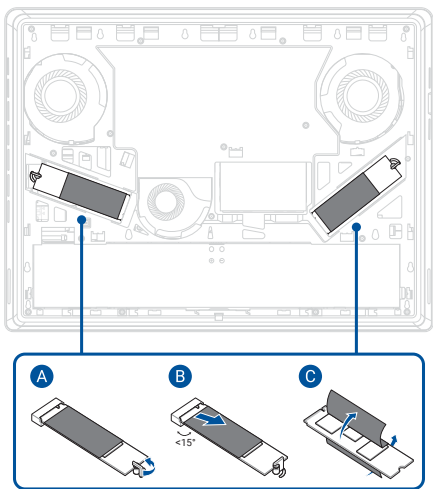

3. Align and attach the stretch release tape to the top cover.
4. Remove the release liner(s) from the top side of the stretch release tape.



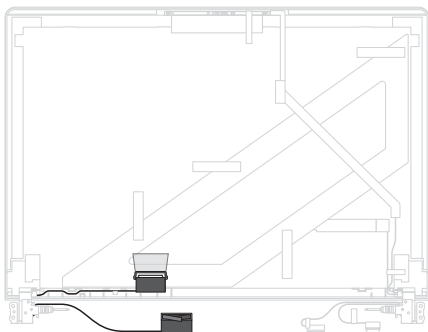
