Description of Change to the Customer:

The Intel® Ethernet SFP+ LR Optics SKU listed in the products affected table has had the following changes:

The transceiver manufacturer discontinued and replaced the previous generation transceiver with the next generation transceiver. This resulted in a change to the part number and the label. The replacement transceiver incorporated changes to the PCB and PCBA (Printed Circuit Board Assembly), LD (Laser Driver), PA (Post Amplifier), Micro-Controller IC, TOSA (Transmitter Optical Sub-Assembly), Laser, ROSA (Receiver Optical Sub-Assembly), Pin PD, and EMI Collar, but form, fit, function, performance and reliability were not changed.

Customers may have received the replacement part beginning June 2020. This is an official notification of the change.
