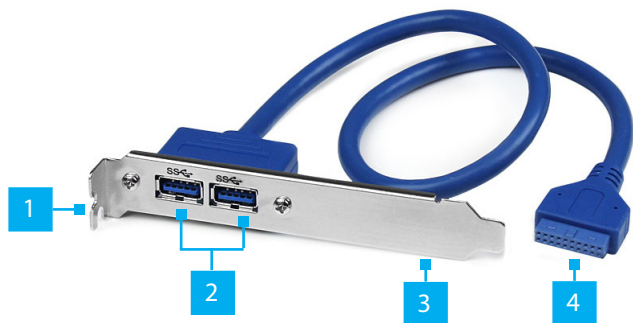


2 Port USB 3.0 A Female Slot Plate Adapter

Product Diagram (USB3SPLATE)



Component	Function
1 Bracket Screw Slots	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Used to secure the Slot Plate Adapter to the Host Computer's Rear Panel.
2 USB-A Ports	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Used to connect USB Devices to the Slot Plate Adapter. USB 3.0 Transfer rates of up to 5Gbps.
3 Bracket	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mounts the Slot Plate Adapter to the Host Computer's Rear Panel.
4 Slot Plate Adapter Connector	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Connects the Slot Plate Adapter to a Host Computer's Motherboard.

Installing the Slot Plate Adapter

Warning: Internal computer parts can be damaged by static electricity. Make sure that you are properly grounded before you open your computer case. You should wear an anti-static strap when you install any computer component. If an anti-static strap is not available, discharge any built-up static electricity by touching a large grounded metal surface for several seconds.

1. Turn off the **Computer** and disconnect any **Peripheral Devices** that are connected (e.g. printers, external hard drives, etc.).
2. Unplug the **Power Cable** from the back of the **Computer**.
3. Remove the **Cover** from the **Computer Case**.

Note: Consult the documentation that came with the **Computer** for details about how to do this safely.

4. Locate a **USB 3.0 Slot** on the **Motherboard**.
5. Gently insert the **Slot Plate Adapter Connector** on the **Slot Plate Adapter** into a **USB 3.0 Slot**.
6. Align the **Bracket** on the **Slot Plate Adapter** with a **Slot** on the **Rear Panel** on the **Host Computer**.
7. Insert a **Screw** (sold separately) through the **Bracket Screw Slot** and into a screw hole on the **Rear Panel**.
8. Using a **Screwdriver** (sold separately), fasten the **Bracket** to the **Rear Panel**.
9. Place the **Cover** back onto the **Computer Case**.
10. Reconnect the **Power Cable** to the back of the **Computer**.
11. Reconnect all of the **Peripheral Devices** that were disconnected in step 1.
12. Connect **USB Peripheral Devices** to the **USB-A Ports** on the **Slot Plate Adapter**.
