PREVIOUS DESIGN

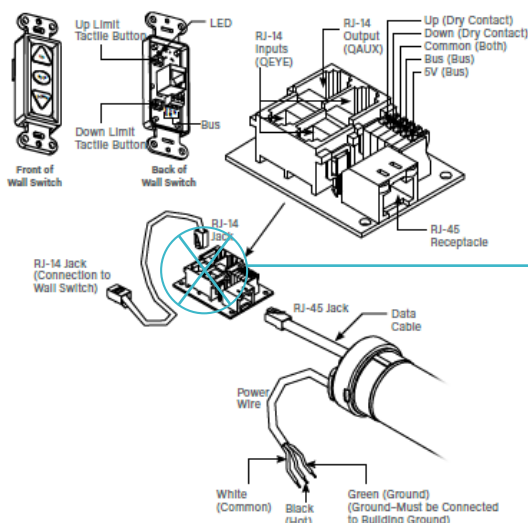

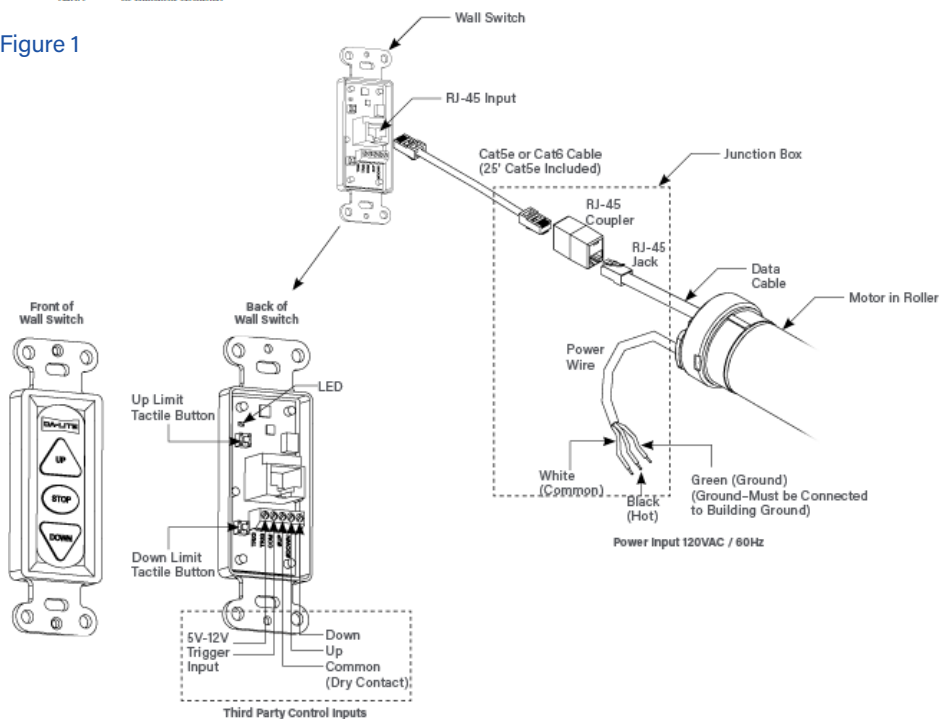


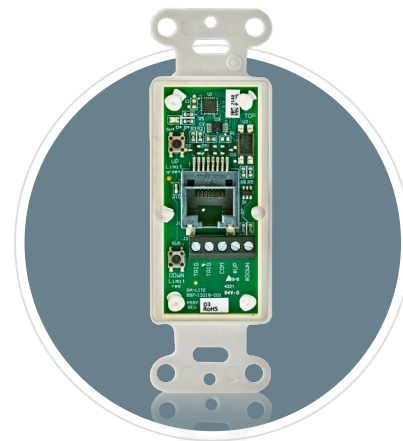

Screen Control At Your Fingertips

What's Not Changing?

- Wall switch still comes standard with screen purchase.
- Motor limit settings still located on back of wall switch.

What's New?

- Ethernet RJ-45 port to connect either directly to the screen or through the screen controller accessory using standard Cat5e or Cat6 cables.

Why We Like It?

- Third-party connections – this is important if purchased without a screen controller accessory.
 - Video projector trigger connection.
 - Dry contact interface connections.

What We're Asking You to Do

**For Third-Party
Controller Projects:**

**If you're planning a project with
connection to a third-party controller:**

- Dry contact connections for momentary contact closure are now located on the back of the wall switch.
- Additionally, we have also added a trigger input for a 5-12V signal to the back of the wall switch.
- Wiring from your third-party controller will now run to the wall switch instead of the screen's junction box.

**What if I'm not planning on mounting
the wall switch to operate the screen?**

- **Option 1** - Place the wall switch in the ceiling near the screen and run your third-party connections to the screen as you would have done in the past.
- **Option 2** - Run the category cable from the screen to the rack and place the wall switch inside the rack. This provides a convenient location for connecting to a third-party control device and a back-up location for screen operation and limit switch adjustment.

**Flexible Connectivity: Choosing Cat5e
or Cat6 Cable for Your System:**

- Now you can use Cat5e or Cat6 cable instead of using our proprietary cable or your own cable. Run category cable from the screen to the wall switch. Adjusting limits remains the same.
