User input syntax key

Text that you must enter into a user interface is indicated by `fixed-width font`.

| Item | Description |
|---------------------------------|--|
| Text without brackets or braces | Items you must type exactly as shown |
| <Text inside angle brackets> | A placeholder for a value you must provide; omit the brackets |
| [Text inside square brackets] | Optional items; omit the brackets |
| {Text inside braces} | A set of items from which you must choose only one; omit the braces |
| | A separator for items from which you must choose only one; omit the vertical bar |
| ... | Items that can or must repeat; omit the ellipsis |

1 Getting started

Select from one of the four options presented on screen or select **Guided Setup**. If no option is selected, the default is Fast Release mode.

2 Managing options

Select the HP Smart Dock icon from the taskbar to open the app.

HP Smart Dock privileged users

HP Smart Dock uses the user group HP Smart Dock Privileged Users to determine which users are privileged. Windows® administrators are also considered privileged users even if they are not listed in the HP Smart Dock Privileged Users group.

To manage user groups for the options **Privileged Access** and **PIN & Privileged Access**, open **Windows Administrative Tools > Computer Management > Local Users and Groups > Groups > HP Smart Dock Privileged Users**.

To add or manage users, open **Windows Administrative Tools > Computer Management > Local Users and Groups > Users**.

Importing and exporting settings

HP Smart Dock allows you to save your settings, including configuration mode and PIN (if created), to an encrypted .xml file. You can also import previously saved settings.

1. Select the gear icon.
2. Select **Export Settings** to save your current settings into an xml file.

- or -

Select **Import Settings** to import previously saved settings.

Reset

- ▲ Select the gear icon, and select **Reset**. This will clear all configuration options, including the PIN, and set HP Smart Dock to Fast Release mode.
