

Notes

Maintenance

- Must be repaired by professionals
- When moving, cleaning or disassembling the purifier, it must be stopped and disconnected from the power supply
- It is forbidden to replace the power cord without authorization. If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by a professional of its manufacturer, maintenance department or similar depart-ment in order to avoid danger.
- Filter needs to be replaced regularly. To change the Filter, please contact the qualified service provider authorized by our local company.


Use

- Do not operate with wet hands
- Do not press hard on the top control panel of the machine
- Do not place items on the top of the machine
- Do not insert foreign objects into the air inlet and outlet

Use Restrictions

- Prohibit the storage of flammable and explosive gases at the place where the purifier is used
- Avoid long-term direct sunlight
- It is forbidden to use in places such as bathrooms where moisture is heavy and water is easy to pour.
- Do not place this machine on a slope or other uneven places
- Do not use this machine in a oil-smoke environment, such as kitchens.
- Do not use this machine outdoors

Installation

1 Take off the back cover.




2 Remove the filter and the protective covering on the filter.





Inset the filter into the unit and consult the filter for correct installation direction.





4 Reattach the back cover of the unit.

Purification volume button


Press the speed button to select different cleaning levels



On/off button

Press the Power On / Off button to activate your air purifier

This product will default to the last working gear each time you turn on the machine.



Control and Status Display Panel



UV button

To activate the UV function press the UV button

The UV lamp can be visually displayed by blue light when it is working

The blue light on the UV button will flash continuously indicating that it is time to replace the filter.

After the filter replacement is completed, push and hold the UV button for 3 seconds to reset filter change indicator.

Filter cleaning and replacement

Cleaning:

- -It is recommended to clean the filter twice a week with soft brush or household vacuum cleaner.
- -Do not use water to wash the filter.

Filter replacement:

- -Reference to Installation
- -After the filter replacement is completed, push and hold the UV button for 3 seconds to reset filter change indicator.



Our recommended replacement timing is a guide only and can be longer or shorter depending upon your environment.



Correct placement

In order to achieve better cleaning effect and avoid the influence of metal shielding effect on communication, please ensure that the air purifier is more than 12 inch away from the wall and other obstructions when using it, and maintain a distance of more than 20 inch from the metal/appliance.










| Technical Parameters

- 1. The performance parameters in the table are measured before delivery and are for reference only.
- 2. Due to product improvement, the following parameters may be changed and shall refer to the product nameplate parameters.
- The applicable area is according to the theoretical value calculated by 1.55 x CADR particulate matter; with the use of different environments or outdoor pollution and other factors, the applicable area will also change.
- 4. Purifying principle: The air purifier blows air into the machine and filters the air through the built-in filter core. It can mainly play the role of filtering dust (such as PM2.5), formaldehyde, odor, sterilization and others.

| Troubleshooting Guide

Before you ask for maintenance, please check according to the table below.

Problems encountered	Reasons	Solutions
Purifier cannot run	 It is possible that the power cord is not plugged or poor contact with power cord May not turn on the power switch It is possible that the filter is not installed in place and safety switch is not triggered 	 Please connect power and make good contact Please turn on the power switch Please properly install the filter and buckle the back cover(reference to page 4)
The effect is bad to eliminate smoke and odor	 It is possible that the filter assembly is not installed well It is possible that the filter assembly has reached the end of life It is possible that the air inlet is blocked by foreign matter 	 Please properly install the filter assembly Please replace the new filter assembly Please remove foreign matter from the air inlet
Filter cleaning light does not extinguish	 It may be that the "UV" button is not long pressed for 3 seconds after the filter assembly is replaced. 	- After cleaning the filter assembly, long press the "UV" button for 3 seconds
It is hard to eliminate the odor and smoke	It may be that the filter assembly is also wrapped in a packaging bag	 Please remove the packaging bag outside the filter assembly

Please send it to repair in case of the following:

- 1. If the operation is abnormal or the machine does not operate, and the above method is invalid;
- 2. Substances or water from the outside have entered and abnormal operation has occurred.





The Eureka three-year limited warranty

("Eureka"), subject to the terms and conditions herein, warrants this air purifier to be free from defects in material and workmanship for a term of three years from the date of original purchase when used in accordance with the Eureka operating and maintenance instructions and under normal household usage. This warranty is granted only to the original purchaser and members of immediate household, and is applicable only to original purchases from Eureka authorized resellers.

What Eureka will do:

Eureka will, at its option, repair or replace a defective air purifier or air purifier part that is covered by this warranty. Repairs may be performed using new or refurbished parts that meet or exceed elects to replace the air purifier, the replacement may be a reconditioned unit. Depending on availability of products, Eureka reserves the right to provide you with a replacement product that is the same or similar, or substitute equivalent of the original product. As a matter of warranty policy, Eureka will not refund the consumer's purchase price.

This warranty does not cover:

 Damages or malfunctions resulting from: improper or unreasonable use or maintenance, abuse, negligence, failure to follow instructions contained in any written materials that accompany the product, deterioration by reason of excess moisture, corrosive atmosphere, lightning, power surges, connections to improper voltage supply, unauthorized alteration, or other external causes such as extremes in temperature or humidity, modifications, scratches or discoloration. accidents, misuse, or acts of God.
