Blender and Burnisher

- The Burnisher is a hard colourless pencil which can be used to create a varnish effect over colour pencil drawings. Apply the burnisher then rub with your finger to bring out the polished effect. The Burnisher can also be used for the wax resist technique.
- The Blender pencil can be used in 2 different ways, firstly to blend 2 different colours together, secondly to push a single colour into the grain of the paper. It smooths the pencil marks so individual strokes and hard edges are softened.



Use a Derwent burnisher pencil to draw your required design, this will add a layer of wax to your surface, then add your colour. The wax layer will resist the colour being applied thus leaving that part of your drawing white.
