Dollies – General Care & Maintenance Instructions

Our Dollies are built to last, and with a little help from you, they will stay strong and clean for years to come. Here are some tips:

- Store dollies in a dry environment to prevent rust on metal components and warping of wooden platforms.
- Keep dollies away from direct heat sources like radiators, space heaters, or direct sunlight to prevent warping, weakening, or discoloration of materials.
- Regularly clean dollies with a damp cloth to remove dust and dirt. Promptly clean up spills to prevent buildup or stains on the surface.
- Use a solution of mild soap and warm water to clean the platform and wheels. For tougher grime, a soft-bristle brush can help remove debris without scratching.
- After cleaning, dry the dolly thoroughly with a clean cloth to prevent water damage or rust on metal components.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasives, or pressure washers, as they can damage the surface and compromise the bearings in the wheels. Also, ensure not to submerge the dolly in water to protect its moving parts.



STEEL

Always test a new cleaning product in an inconspicuous area to ensure it is safe to use.

KEEP IT SIMPLE

- Dip a soft cloth or sponge into dish soap with warm water, wring it out, and wipe down the entire surface.

STAIN REMOVAL

- For any stubborn spots or stains, use a soft-bristle brush to gently scrub the area. To prevent future rust, you can apply a thin layer of car wax or a metal protectant to the steel parts of the chair. This creates an added barrier against moisture.

DRYING IMPORTANCE

- Use a towel or dry cloth to thoroughly dry it to prevent water spots and rust. Allow the dolly to air dry completely in a well-ventilated area before storing or using them.

WHAT TO AVOID

- Do not use abrasive cleaners or steel wool, as these can scratch and damage the steel surface.



Carpet

- Avoid using bleach or strong chemical cleaners, as they can damage fibers and discolor the carpet. Also, avoid excessive water, which can soak the padding and lead to mold growth.
