- #2 Phillips Head Screwdriver
- #4 Slotted Screwdriver
- Standard Socket Set
- 5/16" Socket

MOUNTING THE BASE

GROMMET MOUNTING

1. Insert carriage bolt (N) through adapter plate (D) as shown. **(FIGURE A)**
2. Assembly adapter plate (D) to pole base (G) using (4x) flat head screws (K) and tighten using 4mm hex key (T) as shown. **(FIGURE A)**
3. Apply (4x) adhesive pads (R) around the bottom of adapter plate (D) evenly spaced. **(FIGURE A)**
4. Insert pole base assembly into grommet hole in work surface. Using grommet plate (J) and knob (P), tighten base securely to work surface. **(FIGURE A)**

NOTE: If using grommet hole for wire management, position assembly with cutout in line with wires before tightening assembly in place.

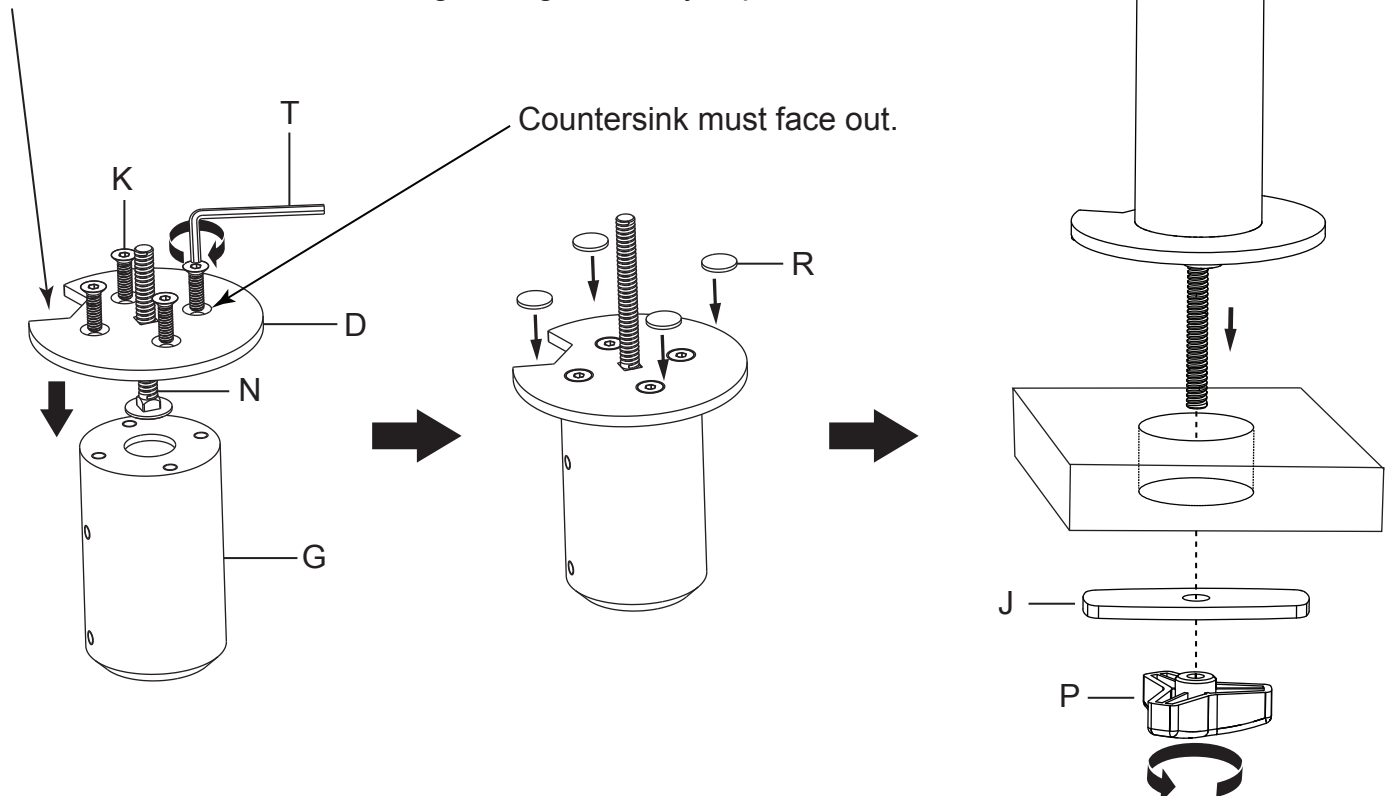

MOUNTING THE BASE (CONTINUED)

CLAMP MOUNTING

1. Attach pole base (G) to clamp assembly (E) using (4x) flat head screws (K) and tighten using 4mm hex key (T) as shown. **(FIGURE B)**
2. Apply (4x) adhesive pads (R) around the bottom of clamp bracket (E) evenly spaced. **(FIGURE B)**
3. Slide assembly over work surface and tighten securely in place. **(FIGURE B)**

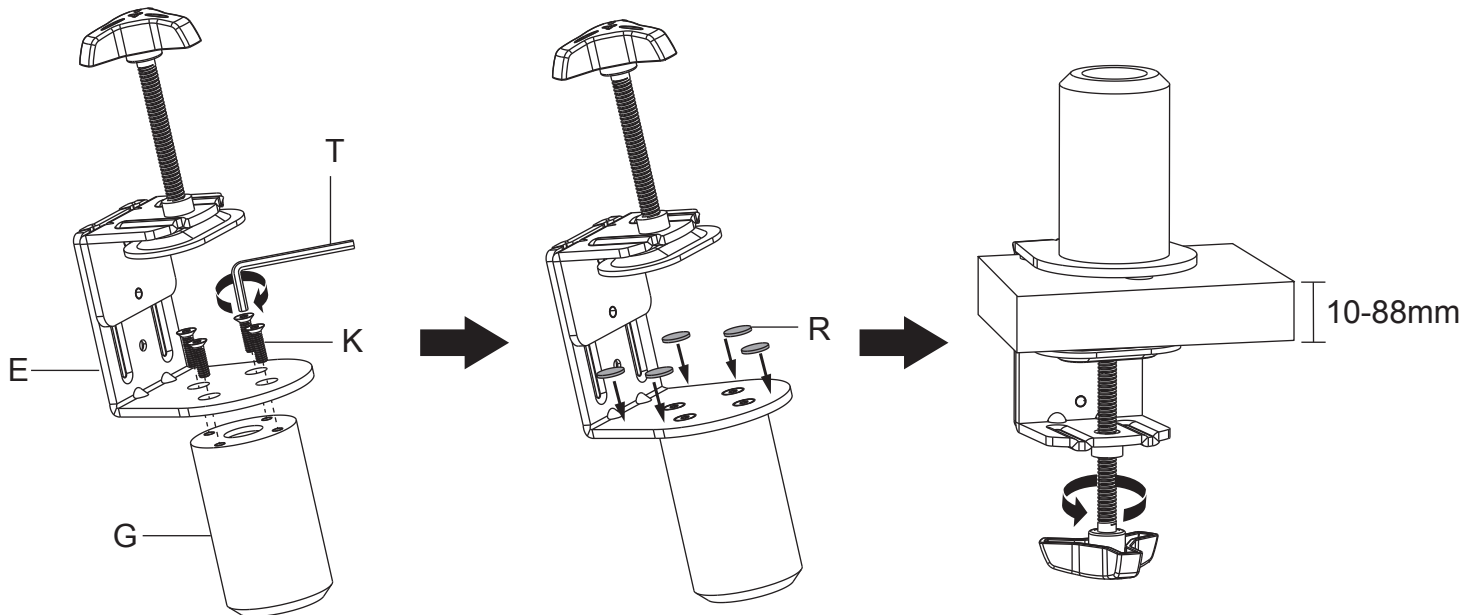

MOUNTING THE BASE (CONTINUED)

VIEWPOINT CONSOLE MOUNTING

1. Insert short carriage bolt (L) into cup mount plate (F) as shown. **(FIGURE C)**
2. Attach cup mount plate (F) to pole base (G) using (4x) head screws (K) and tighten using 4mm hex key (T) as shown. **(FIGURE C)**
3. Apply (4x) adhesive pads (R) over each screw head. **(FIGURE C)**
4. Select the mount location along the back of the ViewPoint console frame and remove protective dustcap nearest to your desired mount position and thread the base assembly into frame tightening base down securely. **(FIGURE C)**

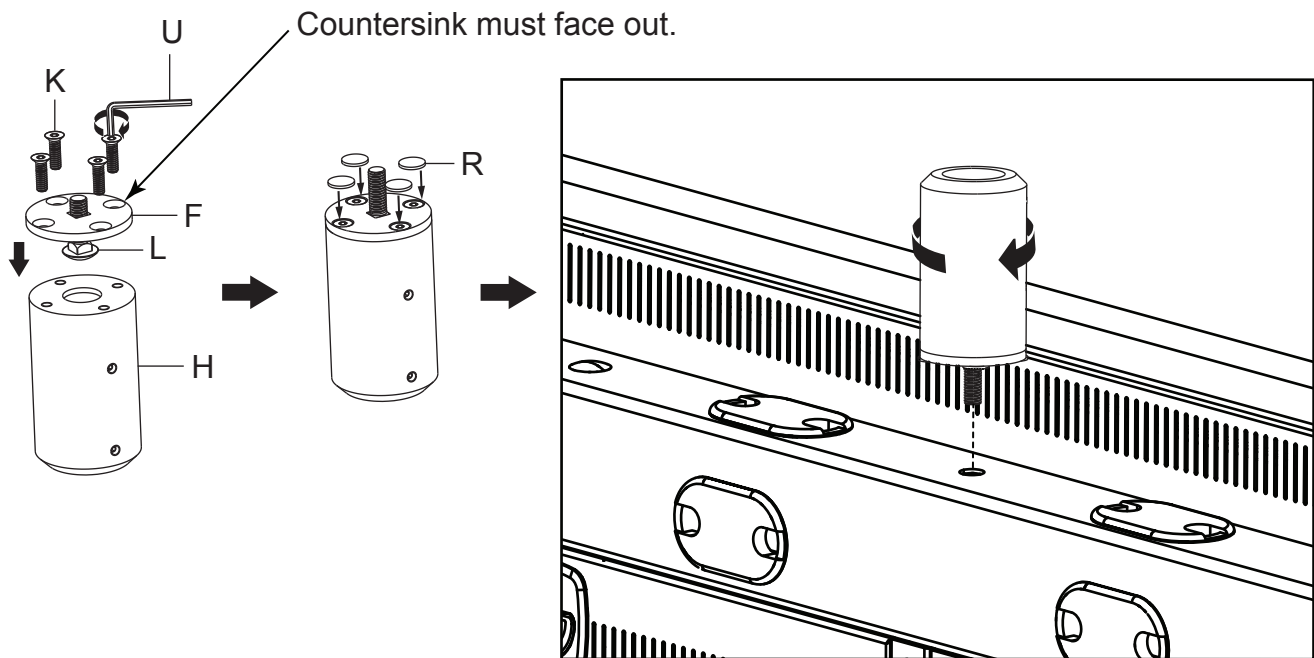
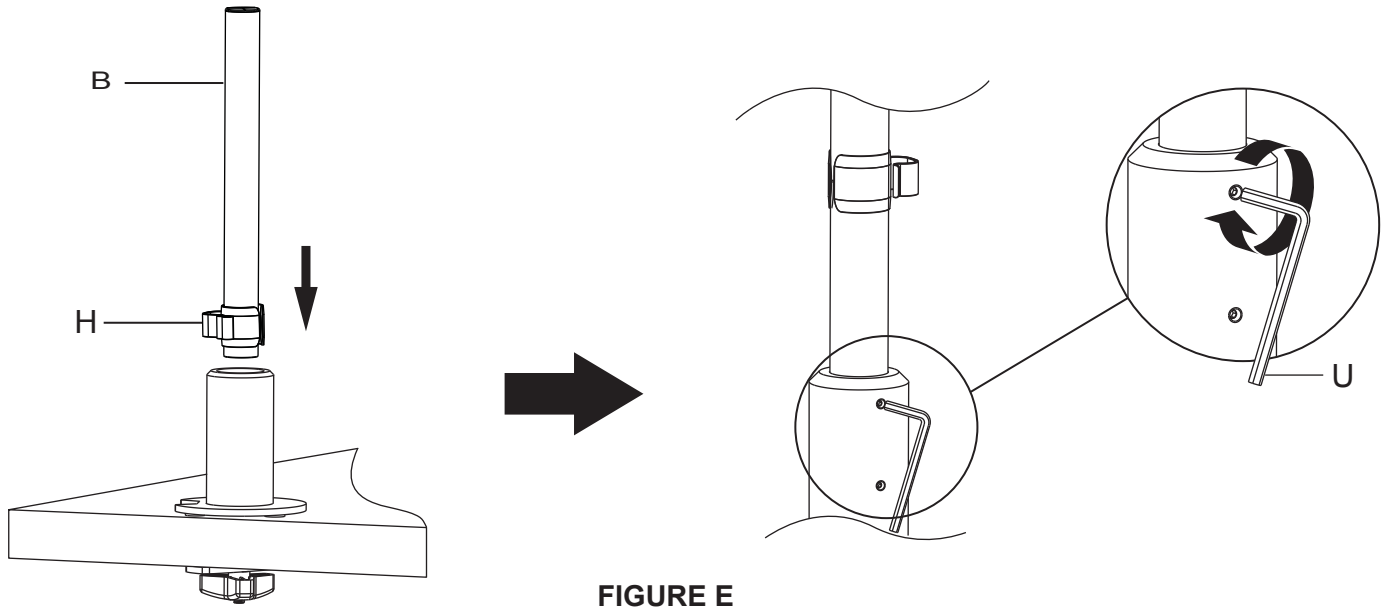

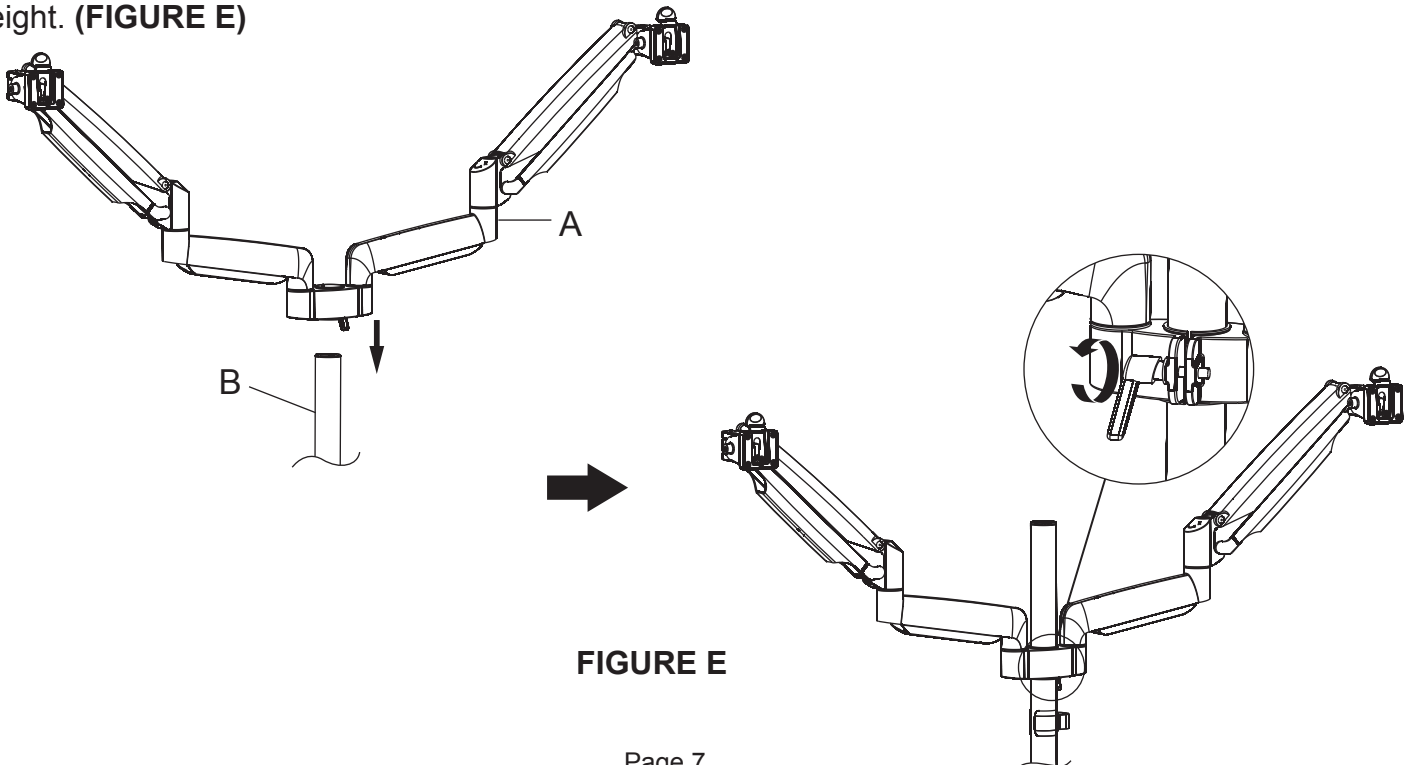
ASSEMBLING POLE TO BASE

1. Slide cable management clip (H) onto pole (B) as shown. **(FIGURE D)**
2. Loosen set screws in pole base (G) and push onto pole (B) until it bottoms out. **(FIGURE D)**
3. Using 3mm hex key (U), tighten set screws to lock pole onto base. **(FIGURE D)**



MOUNT ASSEMBLY

1. Slide arm assembly (A) onto pole (B) and tighten clamp wing nut on back of assembly at the desired height. **(FIGURE E)**



FLUSH DISPLAY MOUNT BRACKET INSTALLATION

1. Using supplied display mount screws, select the appropriate screw size and length ensuring screw does not bottom out in mounting hole, or damage to display may occur.

NOTE: If you feel resistance, stop immediately and try a shorter screw. If supplied screws are still too long, use supplied spacers to take up slack.

2. Align vesa plate (C) with mounting holes on the back of display. Using (4x) display mount screws (M-A - M-D) and (4x) washers (M-E) to secure the display mount brackets to each display. **(FIGURE F)**

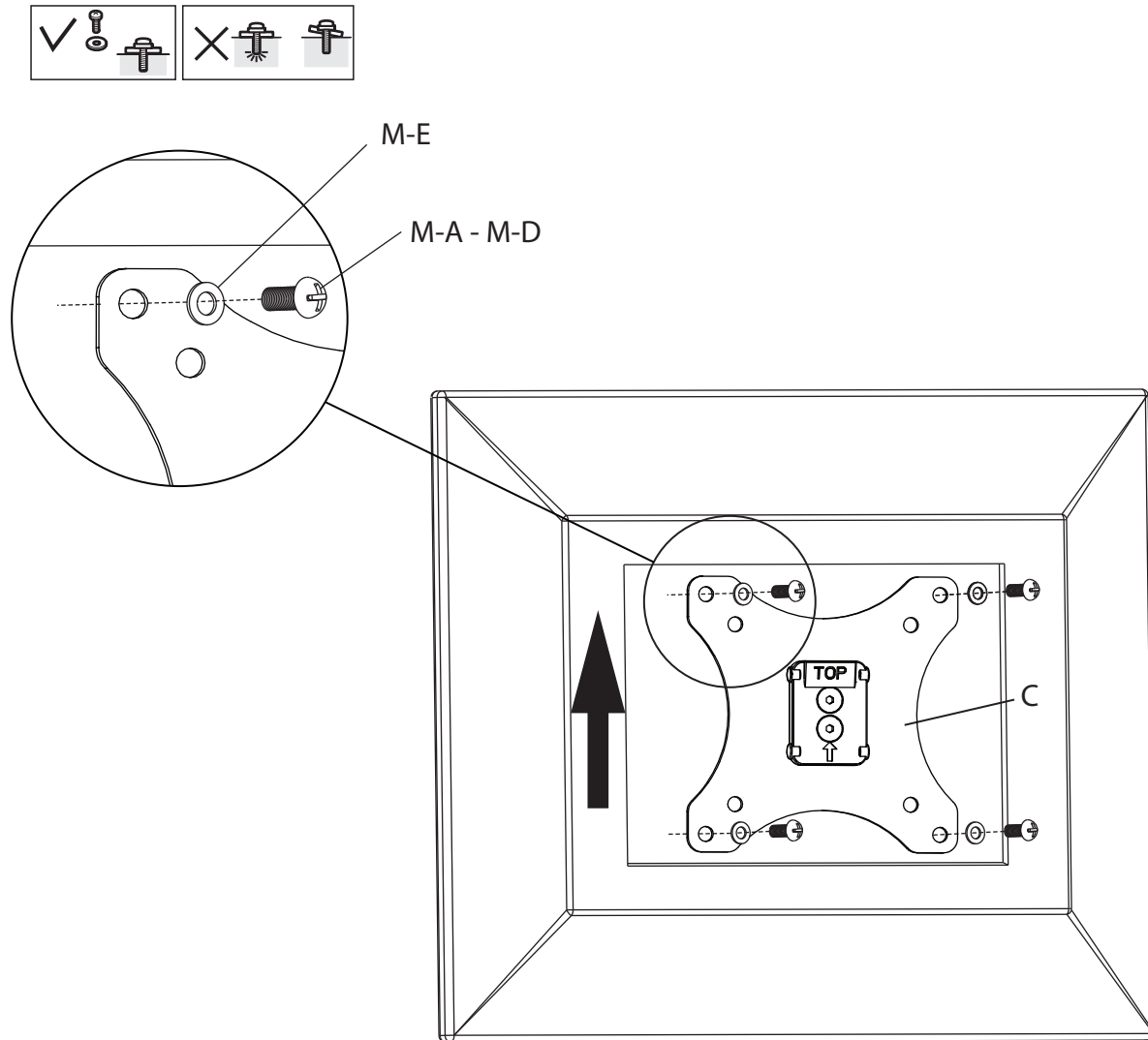

RECESSED OR RAISED BACK DISPLAY MOUNT BRACKET INSTALLATION

1. Using supplied display mount screws, select the appropriate screw size and length ensuring screw does not bottom out in mounting hole, or damage to display may occur.

NOTE: If you feel resistance, stop immediately and try a shorter screw. If supplied screws are still too long, use supplied spacers to take up slack.

2. Align vesa plate (C) with mounting holes on the back of display. Using (4x) display mount screws (M-A - M-D), (4x) washers (M-E) and (4x) spacers (M-F) to secure the display mount brackets to each display. **(FIGURE G)**

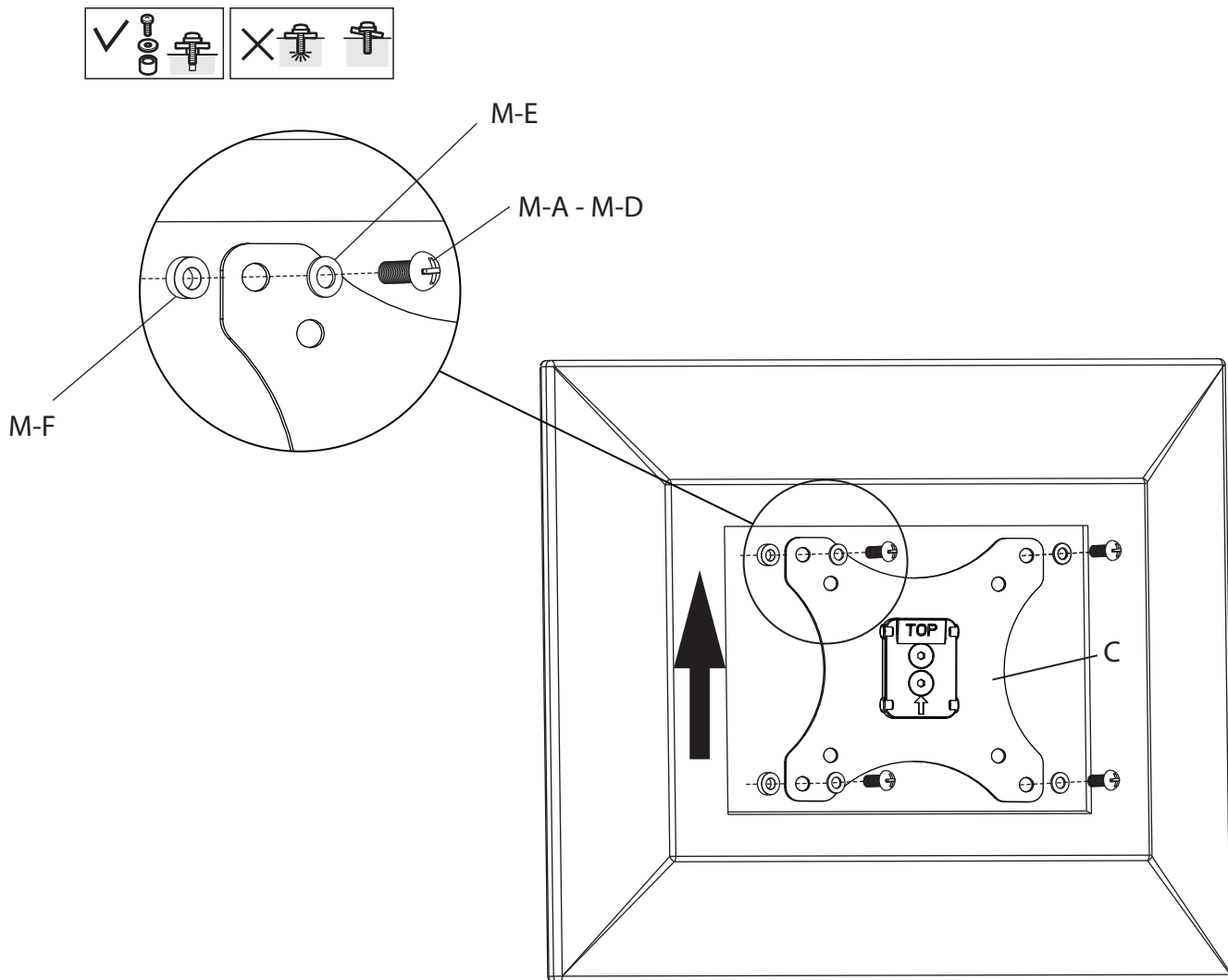

MONITOR INSTALLATION

To attach monitor:

1. Pull tab back.
2. Slide vesa plate mounting tabs into slot on arm assembly knuckle plate until it clicks, locking monitor in place. **(FIGURE H)**

To remove monitor:

1. Pull tab back.
2. Lift monitor off arm assembly.

NOTE: Arrow must face up.

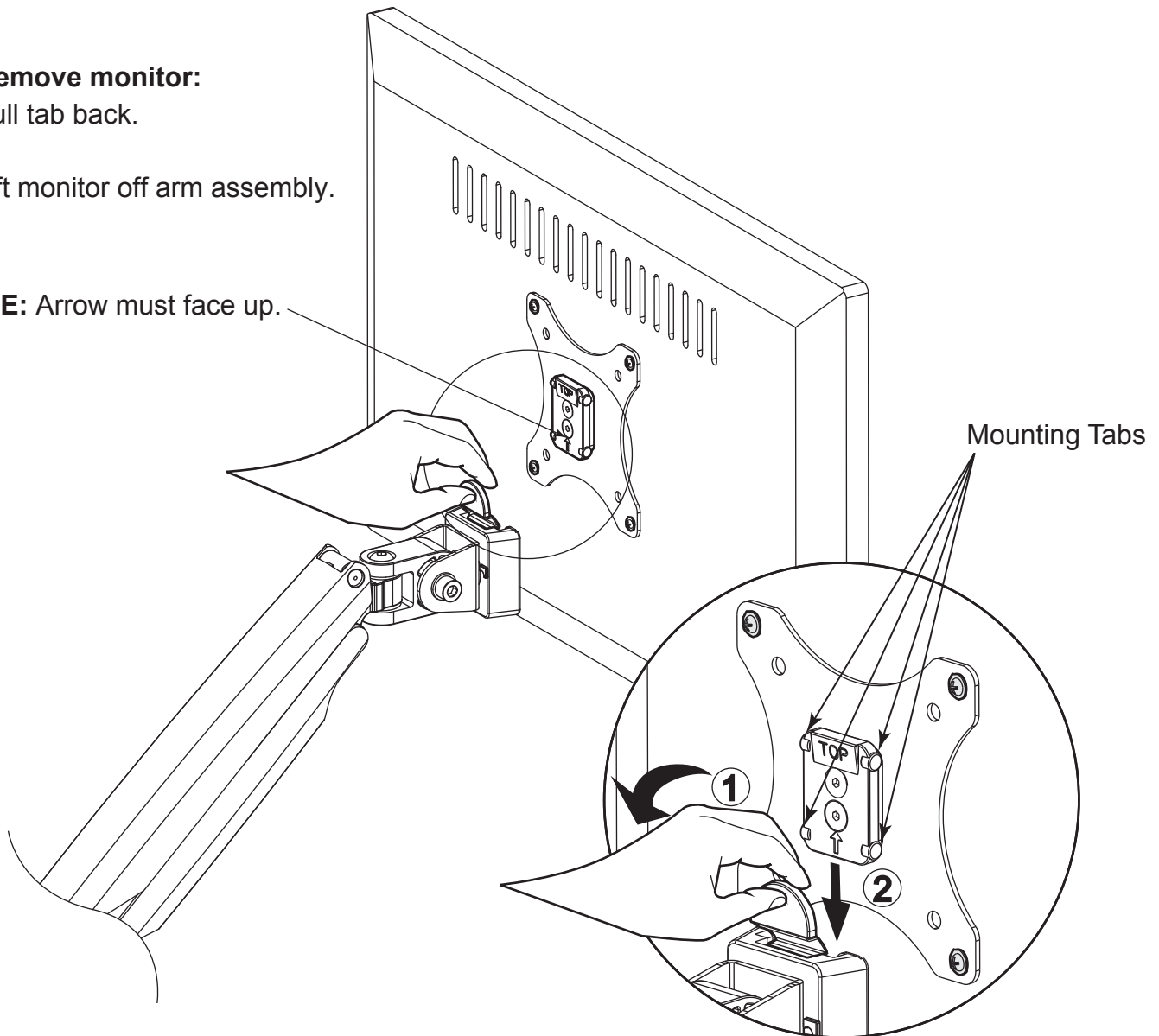

ADJUSTMENT

1. To adjust arm vertical tension, use a 6mm hex key (S) while pressing down on arm. Turn screw clockwise for less tension and counter clockwise for more vertical arm tension.
2. To adjust display angle, loosen socket cap screws on the side of the monitor mount knuckle using 6mm hex key (S) and retighten when desired angle is set. **(FIGURE J)**

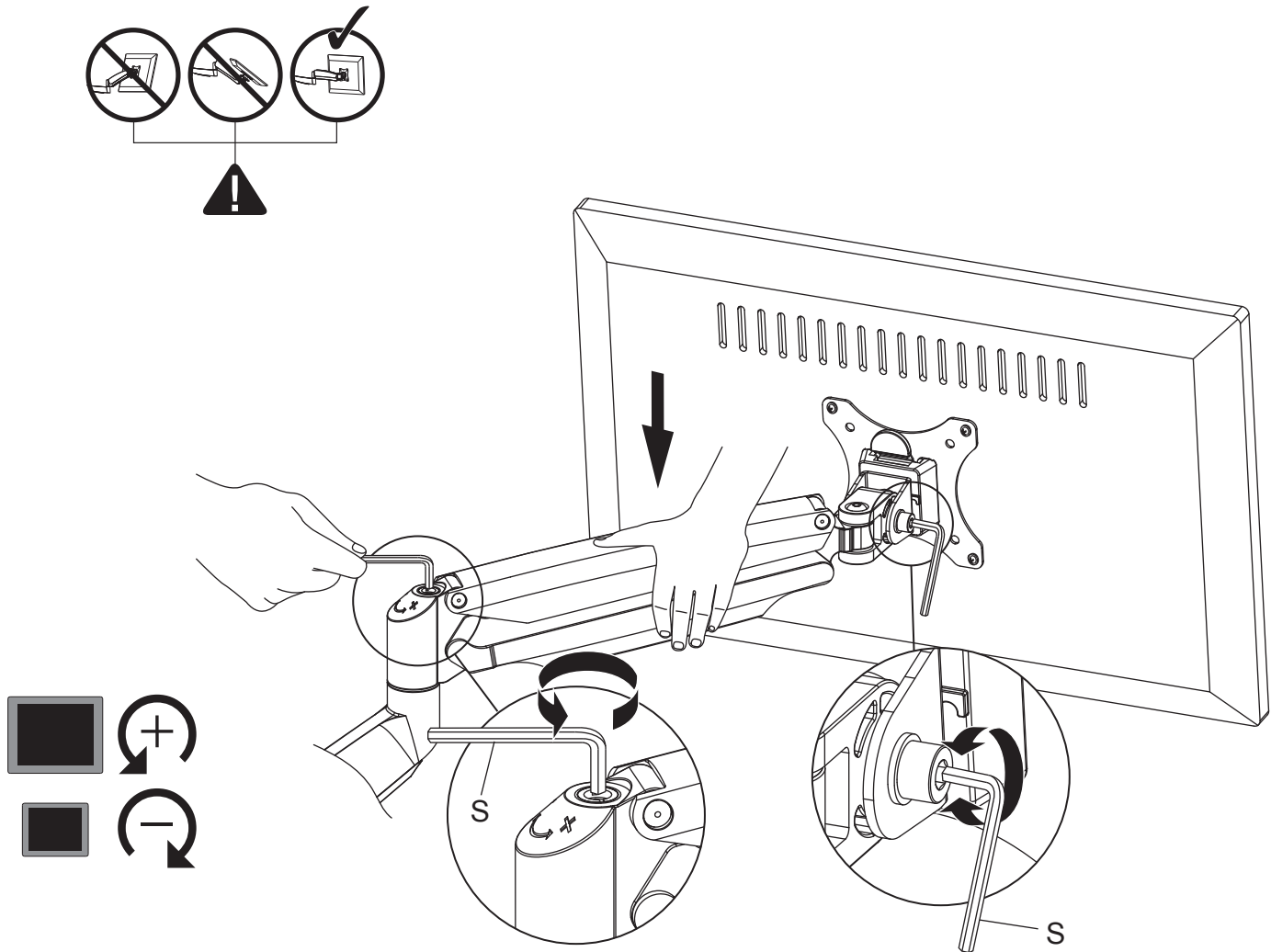

CABLE MANAGEMENT

1. To remove front cable management cover, lift tabs on each corner to unhook alignment pins from each hole while pulling downward. To reinstall, snap each pin into locator holes on each corner of cover. **(FIGURE K)**
2. To remove rear cable management cover, grasp cover and slide forward to unhook. To reinstall, position cover slightly forward so it is flush with bottom of arm and slide cover back to lock in place. **(FIGURE K)**
3. Route cables through cable management covers and reinstall covers. **(FIGURE K)**

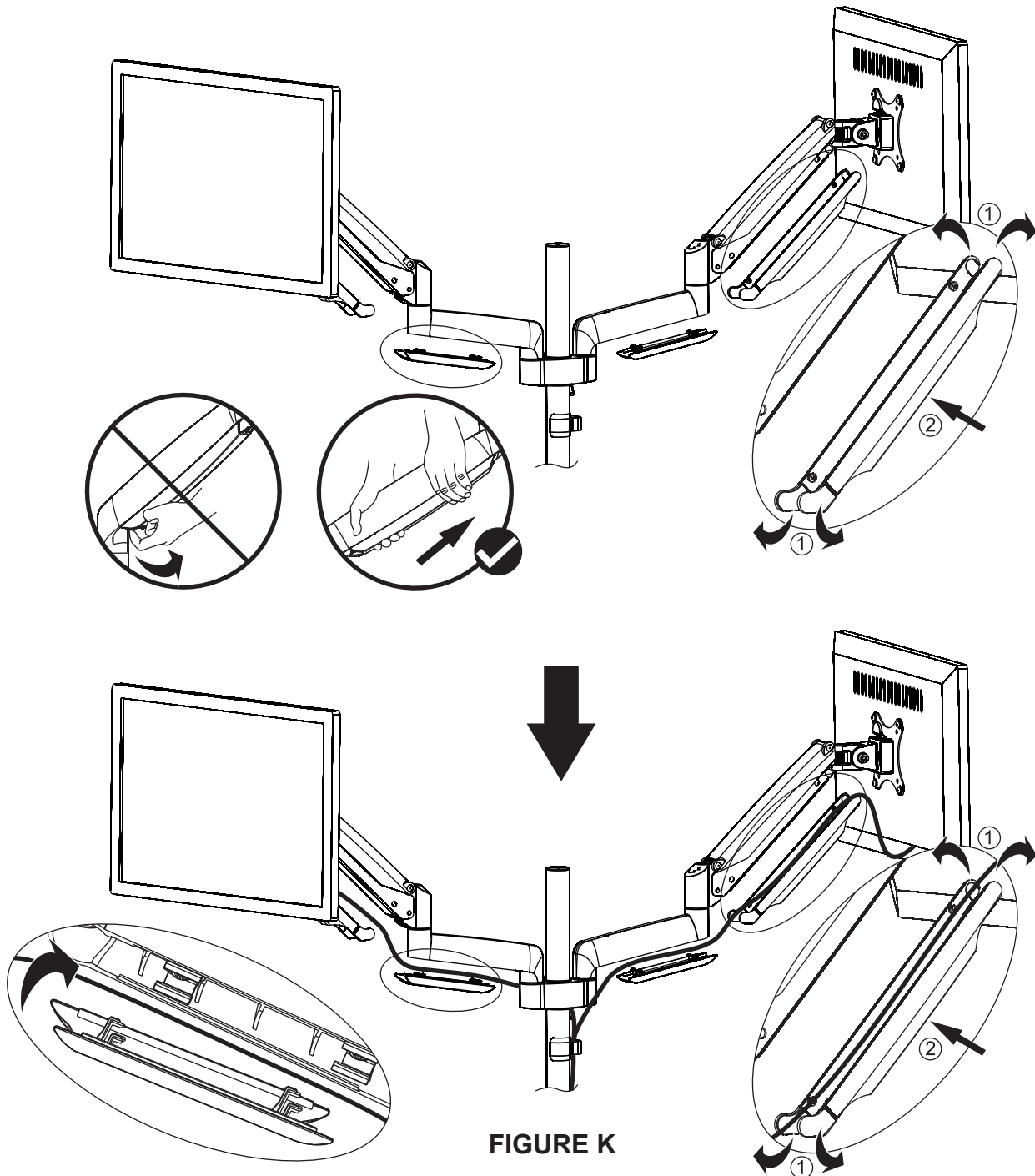

2. Route cables through cable management clip (H).

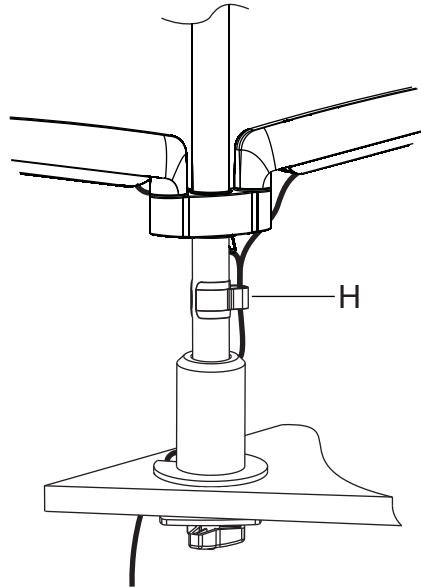

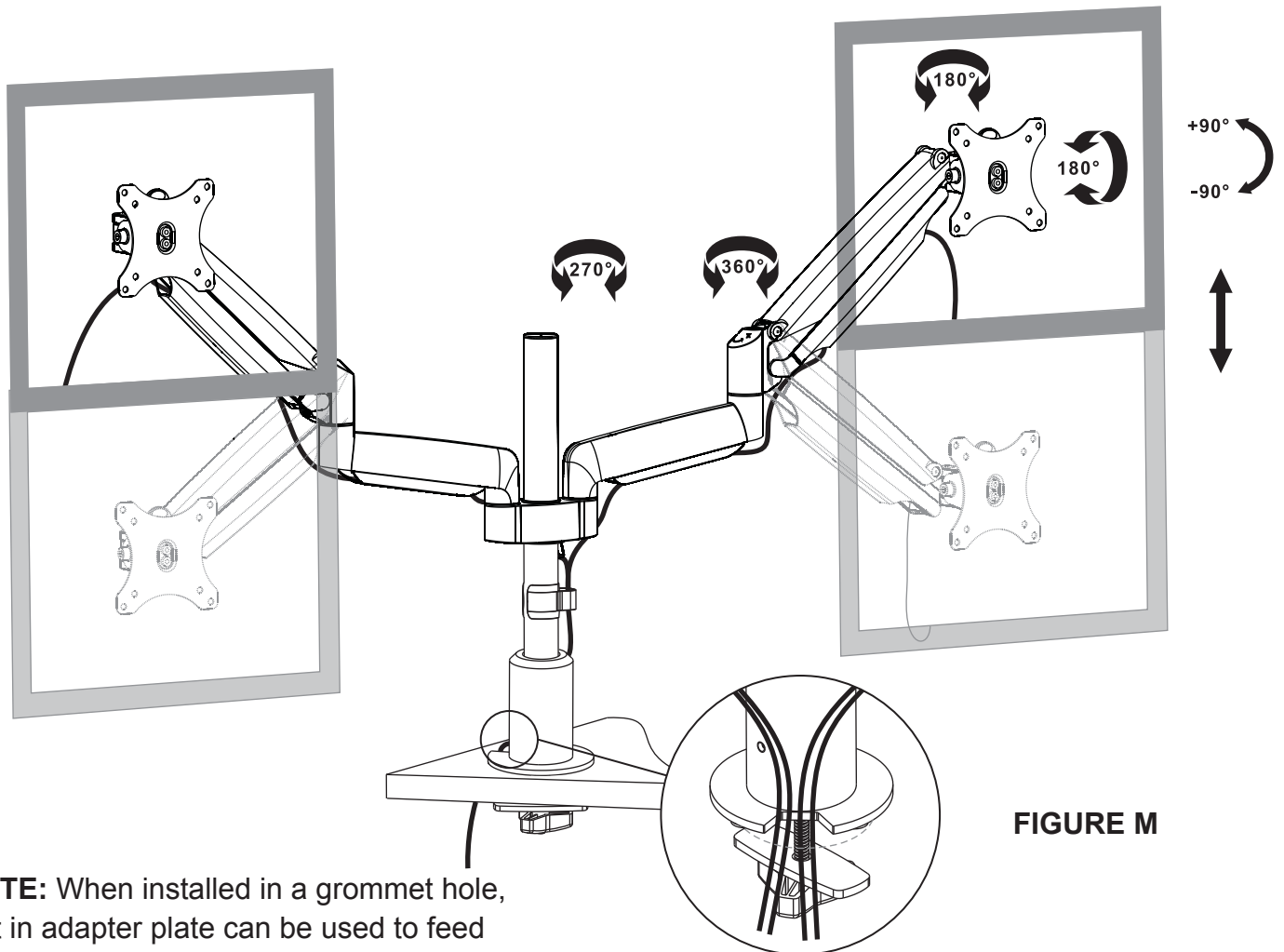
