
• To cancel detachment, press the **Fn** and **1** keyboard keys at the same time after the above operation.

OS processing by pressing the **fn** and **1** keyboard keys at the same time requires some time. If the keys are pressed in succession in a short period of time, the key inputs are ignored. If the key inputs are ignored, wait for a while, and press the **fn** and **1** keyboard keys at the same time again.

- ② Release the detach lock (A).
- 3 Slide the release lever (B) in the direction of the arrow.



④ Detach the tablet from the keyboard base.



CAUTION

- When detaching the tablet from the keyboard base, hold the position at the locations dashed line circled in the illustration.
- Attach/detach the tablet on a flat surface.
- When attaching/detaching the tablet, securely hold the keyboard.



• Do not detach the tablet in the rain.


Attaching the tablet to the keyboard base

• Clean the Tablet terminals (C) with a dry cloth. (Attached dust may cause a contact failure.)




① Push the tablet at the locations illustrated by the dashed area in a downward direction. Release lever (B) will return to the direction of the arrow shown in ①.



CAUTION

 When inserting the tablet, place the keyboard base on a hard stable surface or hold the bottom side of the keyboard base securely with your hand.



② Raise the detach lock (A) above to the locked position.

NOTE

 Confirm that the orange-colored signs near the detach lock and the release lever can not be seen.

The tablet can be attached facing the reverse direction.

CAUTION

• Depending on the shape of the tablet's rear, you may not be able to operate the unit with the tablet attached in the direction illustrated. Be sure to verify this before actual use.

• Do not attach the tablet in the rain.
