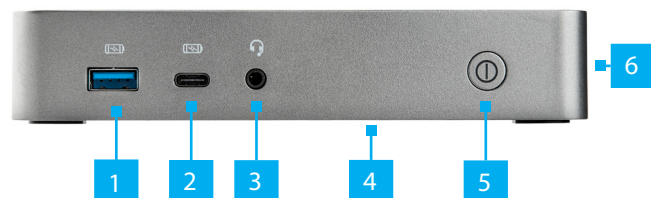


USB-C Dual Video 1080p Monitor, USB 3.1 Gen 1 Dock

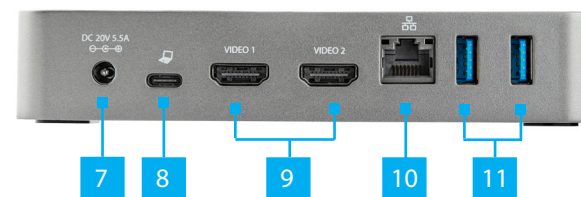
Product Diagram (DK30CHHPD/DK30CHHPDUK/ DK30CHHPDEU/DK30CHHPDAU)

Front



Component	Function
1 USB-A Port	- Used to charge a connected USB Device. - Used to connect USB Devices to the Docking Station (flash drive, etc.). - BC 1.2 Compliant. 7.5W of power output. - Charges with or without a connection to the Host Computer.
2 USB-C Port	- Used to charge a connected USB Device. - B.C. 1.2 compliant. 7.5 W of power output. - Charges with or without a connection to the Host Computer.
3 3.5 mm Audio Port	Used to connect an Audio Device to the Docking Station (headset, microphone, etc.).
4 Mounting Holes (x 4)	Used to mount the Docking Station to a desk or wall. Note: Located on the bottom of the Docking Station.
5 Power Button	Used to turn the Docking Station On/Off.
6 Lock Slot	Used to secure the Docking Station to a secure stationary object. Note: Located on the side of the Docking Station.

Component	Function
7 Power Connector	Used to power the Docking Station by connecting the Universal Power Adapter to the Docking Station.
8 USB-C Host Port	- Used to connect the Host Computer to the Docking Station. - Used to charge the connected Host Computer. - Power Delivery 3.0. 60W of power output.
9 HDMI Video 1 and 2 Ports (x 2)	- Used to connect two HDMI Display Devices to the Docking Station. Maximum Resolution: 1920x1200 @ 60 Hz.
10 RJ-45 Port	Used to connect a Network Device to the Docking Station.
11 USB-A Ports (x 2)	Used to connect USB Devices to the Docking Station (mouse, keyboard, etc.).

Powering the Docking Station

1. Connect the **Universal Power Adapter** to the **Power Connector** on the **Docking Station**.
2. Connect the **Power Cord** to the **Universal Power Adapter** and to an **AC Electrical Outlet**.

3. Press the **Power Button** on the **Docking Station** to turn the **Docking Station** On.

Connecting a Host Device

- Connect a **USB-C Cable** to the **USB-C Port** on the **Docking Station** and the other end to a USB-C port on the **Host Computer**.

Connecting Display Devices

1. Connect an **HDMI Cable** (sold separately) to the **HDMI Video 1 Port** on the **Docking Station** and the other end to the HDMI port on the **Display Device**.
2. Repeat step 1 to connect a second **Display Device**.

Connecting a Network Device

- Connect a **CAT 5e/6 Cable** to the **RJ-45 Port** on the **Docking Station** and the other end to an RJ-45 port on a **Network Device**.

Connecting Peripheral Devices

1. (Optional) Connect a **USB Storage Device** or other **USB Peripheral** (mouse, tablet, phone, etc.) to one of the **USB-A Ports** on the **Docking Station**.
2. (Optional) Connect a **USB Storage Device** or other **USB Peripheral** to the **USB-C Port** on the **Docking Station**.

Driver Installation

Depending on your Host Laptop’s operating system, the required drivers will automatically be installed when the Docking Station is connected and powered on. If the drivers do not automatically install:
