## DESKTOP INSTALLATION

- Clean your desktop using an alcohol based cleaning solvent and wipe dry
- Determine your layout by considering the configuration of your desk; Take into consideration any corners, grommet holes and wires that may need
- Remove all rail parts (rails, end caps, extenders, connectors) from the original packaging and lay them out in the desired locations (see FIG. A)
- Secure all end caps, rail extenders and corner
- NOTE: Do not remove any backing from the adhesi
- Feed all desired cords through the front of the rails (leaving any plugs outside) and run them through the inside of the rail (see **FIG. B**) until reaching the desired exit point at either the front, back or end of the rail your power source (see CABLE MANAGEMENT TIPS
- i. Install any powered Konnect™ accessories onto the rail in the desired location and route that item's cords

- Secure the rail extenders and/or corner connectors to
- NOTE: For easier access to the adhesive pads disconnect any rail extenders and/or corner connectors secured in step 4
- Starting on the left side of the system and securing one-by-one, peel the protective backing from the bottom of each rail extender and/or corner connectors. to reveal the adhesive pad
- Push the ends of the extenders and/or connectors into the ends of the rails (see FIG. C) and once secured, press the extender and/or connector firmly onto the desktop to secure
- . Secure the end caps to the desktop:
- Starting on the left side of the system, secure all end caps using the process outlined in step 7 (see FIG. D)

  9. Secure all remaining (non-powered) Konnect's accessories to the rail including storage bins, tape












security. If required, adhere the provided hook and loop fastener strips to the bottom of each cord management real near the left and right end caps.





- Locate the screw hole on the back of each end cap to help determine the desired mounting
- Mark two spots approximately 11.25" (for the 12" rail) or 20.75" (for the 21.5" rail) from one another
- and use a level to draw a connecting line Drill holes using a 3/16" bit (see FIG. F) and insert
- anchors with a screwdriver, leaving 1/8" of the
- screw proud from the wall (see FIG. G)
- Line up the screw holes on the end caps and hang the rail over the mounted screws
- Secure all Konnect™ accessories to the rail including storage bins, tape dispensers, etc. (see FIG. H)

# CUBICLE MOUNT INSTALLATION

Cubicle hangers sold separately. This type of installation is intended for individual cable management rails (12" or 21.5" inches only) and cannot be applied to rails linked together b his installation type is not ideal for cord management. Before starting, be sure that the left and right

- end caps are already secured to the rail.
- Place the hangers over the cubicle wall and loosely secure by gently pushing or pulling the top adjuster
- . To adjust the length of the hanger, squeeze the side adjusters and gently pull up or down
- 4. Line up the screw holes on the end caps and hang the rail over the notches on the cubicle
- . Secure the hangers in place by pushing together the top adjuster from step 3 . Secure all Konnect™ accessories to the rail including storage bins, tape dispensers, etc. (see

Measure all cords before running them to ensure they will reach the desired power source

WARNING: Do not exceed 10 lbs. of weight on the rail.

- Cords can enter and exit the rails in three locations: the front, ends and back

- Insert the cord furthest from the power outlet first
- Take into consideration all grommet holes and spaces at your desk where cords can exit the
