
#### Removal

- Place the Chromebox on a flat stable surface with its top side facing down.
- Loosen the screw(s) securing the Chromebox's bottom cover, and with extreme care, remove the bottom cover as shown.



# Installation

- 1. Place the bottom cover into position as shown.
- 2. Tighten the screw(s) on the bottom cover to secure it in place.




# Removal

Remove the wireless card as shown.



#### Installation

1. Install the wireless card as shown.



#### NOTE:

- Connect the black antenna cable to the wireless card connector marked with a black triangle , and connect the white antenna cable to the one marked with a white triangle .
- Connecting antennas to your wireless card may strengthen the wireless signal.
- A soft clicking sound indicates that the antenna has been securely attached to the wireless card.
- 2. Install the component(s) you removed in **Before you begin**.




#### Removal

1. Disconnect the battery cable from the connector.




2. Carefully remove the CMOS battery.

**IMPORTANT!** When removing the battery, be careful not to damage the motherboard or the CMOS battery, which is taped to the motherboard.




# Installation

- 1. Remove the release liner on the battery, if one exists.
- Align the battery as shown, and then affix it to the metal bracket on the motherboard.



3. Connect the cable from the battery to the battery connector on the motherboard.



4. Install the component(s) you removed in **Before you begin**.

# **Heatsink**

**WARNING!** To prevent potential damage to the CPU, you should have the heatsink replaced by a service center near you.

**IMPORTANT!** Thermal paste, thermal pads, liquid metal, or other thermal interface materials must be thoroughly removed and replaced if this component is removed. Ensure that replacement materials are available before proceeding, or contact an authorized service center for assistance.


4. Place the motherboard face down, and remove the heatsink screw(s) one by one in the sequence shown.



5. Remove the heatsink.

#### Installation


 Wipe the CPU and chipset surfaces clean with a clean cloth. Apply several drops of Thermal Interface Material (TIM) to the exposed areas of the CPU and chipset that will come in contact with the heatsink. Ensure that the TIM is spread evenly in a thin layer over the surfaces.





3. Remove the motherboard as shown.




- Locate in the chassis the antenna jack end of the RF cable assembly.
- 5. Remove the hex screw securing the antenna jacks
- 6. Remove the O-ring from the antenna jack.
- 7. Remove the RF cable assembly from the chassis.
- 8. Repeat steps 4 to 7 to remove the other RF cable assembly.




#### Installation

- Insert the antenna jack end of the RF cable assembly into the antenna hole from within the chassis outwards.
- 2. Insert the O-ring removed earlier over the antenna jack.
- 3. Secure the antenna jack using the hex screw removed earlier.




4. Repeat steps 1 to 3 to install the other RF cable assembly.


5. Align and place the motherboard in the chassis as shown.
